I understand that records and information collected about me will be held or released in accordance with state laws regarding confidentiality of such records and information.

I understand that state and local laws require that my therapist report all cases of abuse or neglect of minors or vulnerable adults.

I understand that state and local laws require that my therapist report all cases in which there exists a danger to self or others.

I understand that there may be other circumstances in which the law requires my therapist to disclose confidential information.

- 6. The right to select practitioners of my choice at my expense.

I understand that in some circumstances my therapist may need to exchange information with my primary care physician and that such exchange of information will only take place with my separate, written consent. If I am utilizing health care benefits my therapist may exchange any and all information pertaining to my therapy, to the extent such disclosure is necessary for claims processing, case management, coordination of treatment, quality assurance or utilization review purposes. I understand that I can revoke my consent at any time except to the extent that treatment has already been rendered or that action has been taken in reliance on this consent. I acknowledge that if I do not revoke this consent, it will expire automatically one year after all claims for treatment have been paid or as provided in my particular benefit plan.
